



Dear Parent —

Thank you for requesting an Application for Enrollment from San Luis Obispo Classical Academy! We are honored that you would consider the school and we'd like to make the process for applying as clear as possible. We begin accepting new student applications for the 2010-2011 school year on March 1, 2010, through regular mail or by dropping it off in our office. Because SLO Classical Academy can accept only a limited number of new students, applications will be processed in the order received (based on postmark date or drop off date), and assuming acceptance, spots will also be filled based on this same order. Although applications will be accepted at any time, we encourage interested families to apply early.

Below is the order of operations for applying to SLO Classical Academy:

1. Familiarize yourself as much as possible with the school by spending time on our website, www.sloclassicalacademy.com.
2. Attendance at one of the following Parent Information Meeting is required. Meetings are held on campus at 165 Grand Avenue in SLO from 7:00-8:30 p.m., in the Lewis Library.
 - a. Monday, March 22nd
 - b. Monday, April 26th
3. Gather the following for each student:
 - a. Writing sample from current school year. A copy is fine.
 - b. List of books each student has read during the last 3 months. If not yet reading, please state this and briefly describe your child's understanding of letters, any words read and interest level in reading.
4. Please choose track preferences on the application.
5. Mail or drop off form and work samples, along with **non-refundable** insurance/registration fee of \$250 per student to:

6. Complete kindergarten evaluation (if applicable) and family interview. Upon the completion of your application, you will be contacted within 30 days for a kindergarten evaluation and family interview. Both the evaluation and interview will be scheduled during normal business hours, with no exceptions. Both parents are encouraged to attend if possible. Student attendance is optional for students grades K-5 and while not required for students grades 6-10th — it is recommended if possible.
7. You will be notified by letter whether or not your student(s) have been accepted soon after the interview. If there are no spots in the specific grade level requested, you will be placed on a waiting list. A Code of Conduct and several necessary forms will be included with your acceptance letter. The forms must be read, signed, and returned by July 16, 2010, to make your registration with SLO Classical Academy final.
